**Thank You for a Successful Legislative Day**

On May 15, 30 plus ACCO and PHCC members visited the Statehouse to meet with lawmakers to discuss Residential Licensing (HB 339) and Workforce Development. Legislative Day kicked off with an issues briefing to discuss current issues. After the briefing, members met with over 40 legislators from the Ohio House of Representatives and Ohio Senate. Our day ended with an evening reception that was attended by more than 70 legislators and staff at the Statehouse.

**Legislative Update** Significant progress continues to be made on our licensing bill, HB 339. The focus from opponents remains new residential construction and the definition of “employee.” ACCO and PHCC Ohio have created and sent language needed to amend the bill. Some opponents have agreed to the language, while we wait for a response from home builders.

Other than HB 339, the following licensure bills have been introduced:

- HB 164 License Roofers
- HB 71 License Home Inspectors
- HB 236 License Elevator Contractors
- HB 504 License Interior Designers
- SB 115 License Roofers, Gutter and Downspout Contractors
