HVAC Apprenticeship Program We've been talking about it for months and soon ACCO and PHCC Ohio will be finalizing an HVAC and Plumbing apprentice eLearning program for apprentices who want a non-traditional method of receiving their apprenticeship-related instruction.

Our apprenticeship standards were finally approved by the Ohio State Apprenticeship Council! The program is already recognized by the U.S. Department of Labor, Employment & Training Administration, Office of Apprenticeship, as an option for apprentice training.

Each course is the equivalent of one year of classroom instruction. On-the-job training must be coordinated with a participating employer. The courses offer enhanced course quality and give students fast feedback on their performance.

Since there is no set schedule, apprentices pursuing eLearning must be self-disciplined and self-motivated to maintain steady progress.
