Ohio BWC Payroll true-up reports due by August 15 the Ohio BWC requires that employers reconcile their actual payroll following each policy year. Therefore, each employer must file a true-up report that reflects the actual payroll for the policy year. This report must be completed online and can be accessed through this link [Payroll true-up report](#) *Employers must submit a payroll true-up report even if it has zero payroll. Employers who do not complete the True-Up process on time will be disqualified for all BWC Discounts and Rating Programs for that year

Legislative Watch

Residential licensing: we have had numerous discussions with our sponsor, Rep Tim Schaffer and key stakeholder groups this month. We continue to be aggressive and proactive in addressing any and all concerns expressed primarily by OHBA (Homebuilders) and Direct Energy, with the goal of successfully resolving concerns. Again as previously written, our latest version of that language has been presented to all stakeholders and we continue to await their response.

HB 211, Rep. Jim Hughes (R-Columbus), licensure of Home Inspectors and creation of the Ohio Home Inspector Board passed the House in late session (June 27). It was introduced in the Ohio Senate earlier this month with no further activity (This is a licensure bill, most all of which have met with stiff opposition in the Senate for the past decade and are monitoring closely).
